

Lumina FAQs

What is Lumina?

Lumina is Bolchazy-Carducci Publishers' interactive digital content. Bolchazy-Carducci Publishers has developed Lumina content for *Latin for the New Millennium* Level 1 and Level 2 and *Artes Latinae*.

Lumina: *Latin for the New Millennium* Level 1 and *Latin for the New Millennium* Level 2 are designed to be guided online practice to accompany the *Latin for the New Millennium* textbooks.

Lumina: *Artes Latinae* Level 1 and *Artes Latinae* Level 2 are online courses. These self-teaching Latin courses are revised editions of the *Artes Latinae* DVD program and use the *Artes Latinae* Program Method of teaching. With this online content Bolchazy-Carducci Publishers is offering a weekly online session with a Latin teacher to help students with *Artes Latinae* Latin-specific questions.

How do students access Lumina?

Lumina is available for individual learners and for classrooms. For individuals and classrooms not using an LMS or the LMS does not support LTI, Lumina is available in Moodle. For classrooms with a school LMS that supports LTI, LTI links are provided for the Lumina content.

How long do students have access to Lumina content?


Lumina is sold as a one-year subscription per user. For individual users the subscription is 356 days from the day of purchase confirmation. For schools the one-year subscription is July 15 of the purchase year until July 15 of the next year.

How do schools or individuals purchase Lumina?

Lumina can be purchased from the Bolchazy-Carducci Publishers website: www.bolchazy.com. There are three buying options:

- Individual user
- Classroom without an LMS
- Classroom with an LMS

Select your buying option and check out. You will receive a confirmation email with instructions on how to access the Lumina content based on your purchase. Purchase confirmation for individual users

Individual users purchasing Lumina content will receive an email confirmation of their purchase: “Thank you for your order. Within 24–48 hours you will receive instructions on how to access the Lumina content. Bolchazy-Carducci Publishers will register the user in the Lumina content on Moodle. The user will receive an email with a link to access Lumina content. The email will have a temporary password for the initial login. Lumina users will be asked to create a new password at the initial login.”

Purchase confirmation for classroom using Lumina in Moodle

Classrooms using Lumina in Moodle will receive an email confirmation of their purchase: “Thank you for your order. Please reply to this email with the names and email addresses of your students. Within 24–48 hours of your reply email, you will receive instructions on how to access the Lumina content. Bolchazy-Carducci Publishers will register the classroom teacher and classroom of students in Lumina Moodle. The teacher and the students will each receive an email with a link to access Lumina content. The email will have a temporary password for the initial login. Lumina users will be asked to create a new password at the initial login.”

Purchase confirmation for classroom using Lumina with a school LMS

Classrooms using Lumina in their school LMS will receive an email confirmation of their purchase: “Thank you for your order. Bolchazy-Carducci Publishers will contact you within 24–48 hours of your purchase to make arrangements to deliver the Lumina LTI links for your LMS.”

What are the system requirements to use Lumina?

- **Hardware:** Lumina content requires a computer with internet access. The course is viewed in a web browser, so no additional RAM or disk space is required other than your web browser requirements.
- **Software:** Windows: 7/8/10, VISTA; Apple: Macintosh OS X
- **Web browsers:** Windows: Internet Explorer 10 or above, Mozilla/Firefox 10 or higher, Chrome; Apple: Firefox, Safari 1.x or higher, Chrome 54.0.2840.99m or higher
- **Mobile Devices*:** Web or Moodle App. While viewing content on most smart phones and tablets is supported on mobile web browsers, the activities function better using the Moodle App. The Moodle App is free and available from the Apple App store: <https://itunes.apple.com/us/app/moodle/id633359593?mt=8> and the GooglePlay App store: https://play.google.com/store/apps/details?id=com.moodle.moodlemobile&hl=en_US.

**NOTE: some activities function better using a Windows or Macintosh computer/laptop.*

How are student's scores/grades tracked in Lumina?

Schools using Lumina content in Moodle will be using the scoring "Grading Method" and "Number of Attempts" set by Bolchazy-Carducci Publishers.

- Grading Method currently set to "Most Recent Score"
- Maximum Attempts currently set to "Unlimited"

Schools using Lumina content via LMS (LTI links) can set the "Grading Method" and "Number of Attempts" in their own LMS.
