

CONTRAST WITH OTHER BOLCHAZY-CARDUCCI LATIN GRAMMAR REFERENCES

(1) *Vocabulary Cards and Grammatical Forms Summary for Wheelock's Latin* (also by LaFleur and Tillery) includes a "Grammatical Forms Summary" section. Those cards include the same grammatical charts, but they do not contain the most common syntax included on the *GrammarQuick*. Those cards are also not coated, and are not in as condensed form (15 pages to *GrammarQuick's* 12 pages). The information on syntax included on the *GrammarQuick* cards helps the student gain an overview of grammar *and* syntax, and as such provides a mini-review instead of simply providing the forms themselves.

(2) *Graphic Latin Grammar* (8 pages of laminated cards) includes grammatical charts similar to those found on *GrammarQuick*, as well as some information also on syntax of verbs and cases. *Graphic Latin Grammar* cards also contain information on numerals and prepositions not found on the *GrammarQuick* cards. The *GrammarQuick* cards are designed to accompany Wheelock's Latin, and would be a better reference tool for students using that textbook.
