

# Setting student attempts and scoring methods for Lumina exercises

Lumina exercises have option settings: Change Scoring Method, Change Maximum Attempts, and Complete All Attempts.

Open a Lumina exercise, select the “Actions” drop-down menu to set student attempts and exercise scoring method.



“Change Scoring Method” will allow you to choose the score that will be submitted to the student’s grade. The student’s score will be recorded based on the scoring method selected for the exercise. If the exercise allows multiple attempts the student can attempt the exercise again but only the score matching the specific exercise scoring method will be recorded.







“Change Maximum Attempts” allows you to choose how many times your students can attempt the exercise.



After their final allowed attempt the student cannot attempt the exercise again but they can view information (scores and feedback) for the exercise.



“Complete all Attempts” will complete all student’s attempts and recalculate their scores based on the exercise scoring method. (First score, Most Recent Score, Highest Score, Average Score). Choosing “Complete all Attempts” does not prevent students from trying the exercise again.

When the teacher completes all attempts for an exercise they need to record student’s scores in their gradebook (Learning Management System) at that time.

NOTE: If multiple attempts are allowed for the exercise students will be able to attempt the exercise after the teacher has completed all attempts.
